Item 8. Purposes of the Organization.

- 1. To promote research and study of the causes and effects of eating disorders, substance abuse, depression and related disorders and to educate the public and private sectors about recognizing, treating and preventing eating disorders and substance abuse.
- 2. To operate exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations making of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future United States Internal Revenue Code ("Code").
- 3. To acquire, to own, to dispose of, and to deal with real and personal property and interests therein, and to apply gifts, grants, bequests and devises, and the proceeds thereof in furtherance of the purposes of the Corporation.
- 4. To do such things and to perform such acts to accomplish its purposes as the Board of Directors may determine to be appropriate and as are not prohibited by Sections 501(c)(3), 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(a)(vi) of the Code and to possess all powers which a Corporation organized under the General Not-For-Profit Corporation Act or the Charitable Trust Act of the State of Illinois, as the same from time to time may be amended, shall possess.
- 5. To otherwise operate exclusively for charitable, scientific or educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) and as a public charity pursuant to Section 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(a)(vi) of the Code in the course of which operation:
 - A. No individual member, if any, or trustee of the Corporation shall have title to or interest in the corporate property or earnings in his or her individual or private capacity and no part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, any trustee, officer, individual member or any private individual except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered;
 - B. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, nor shall the Corporation participate in, or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office;

- C. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a Corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code; or (b) by a corporation qualified as a public charity pursuant to Sections 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(a)(vi) of the Code; or (c) by a Corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code.
- 6. In the event of the dissolution or liquidation of the Corporation and after payment or making provision for the payment of all debts and liabilities of the Corporation, all remaining assets shall be distributed to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, as determined by the Board of Trustees.
- 7. Anything herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding, no assets of the Corporation shall be donated, distributed, applied to, paid over or otherwise used or employed in any manner which would disqualify the Corporation from being exempt from taxation under Section 501(a) or 501(c)(3) of the Code.
