ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation is Tabernaculo de Restauracion Betel, Inc.

ARTICLE II. PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal office of the corporation is 1416 Manotak Avenue, Jacksonville, Florida 32210. The mailing address of the corporation is 1416 Manotak Avenue, Jacksonville, Florida 32210.

ARTICLE III. PURPOSE

The corporation is a not for profit corporation. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are as follows:

- (a) The specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate for the advancement of religion and other charitable endeavors by the distribution of its funds for these purposes.
- (b) The general purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate exclusively for charitable and religious purposes, which will qualify it as an exempt organization under 26 U.S.C.A. § 501(c) (3), or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, including, for those purposes, the making of distributions to organizations which qualify as tax-exempt organizations under that Section.
- (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ARTICLE IV. MANNER OF ELECTION

The manner in which the directors are to be elected or appointed shall be by the majority vote of the directors serving from time to time.

ARTICLE V. INITIAL DIRECTORS

ARTICLE VIII. DISPOSITION OF CORPORATE ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, its assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal, state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court located in the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE IX. RESTRICTIONS

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
