ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

OAK GROVE ASSEMBLY OF GOD of PORT ST. JOE, INC.

(A corporation not for profit)

The undersigned subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation, natural persons competent to contract, hereby form a corporation not for profit, under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, and do hereby certify that it has become such corporation under and pursuant to the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is "OAK GROVE ASSEMBLY OF GOD OF PORT ST. JOE, INC." and the initial principal address of the corporation is P.O. Box 967, Port St. Joe, Florida 32457.

ARTICLE II

The period of the duration of this corporation is perpetual and is dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE III

This corporation is organized exclusively for religious and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding sections of any prior or future law or to the

Federal, State or Local government for exclusive public purpose.

ARTICLE IV

The qualifications for membership and the manners of their admission are set forth in the By-Laws of this corporation.

ARTICLE V

The street address and the city of the initial registered office of this corporation is **1613 Madison Avenue Port St. Joe, Florida 32456**. The name of the initial registered agent of this corporation at that address is **Dave Fernandez**.

ARTICLE VI

The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of the corporation and the respective offices held by the same as well as their names and addresses are as follows:

The manner in which the Directors are elected or appointed are as provided in the By-Laws of this corporation.

ARTICLE VII

This corporation is not organized, nor shall it be operated for the pecuniary gain or profit and it does not contemplate the distribution of gains, profits or dividends to the directors thereof and it is organized solely for non-profit purposes. The property, assets, profits and net income of this corporation are irrevocably dedicated to purposes set forth and permitted under Section 501 (C) of the Internal Revenue Code and no part of the profits or net income of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any directors or officers thereof or to the benefit of any private shareholder or individual. Upon the dissolution or winding up of this corporation, the assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for purposes under Section 501 (C) of the Internal Revenue Code and which has established its tax-exempt status under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE VIII

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Sections

501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding sections of any prior or future law or to the Federal, State or Local government for exclusive public purpose.

ARTICLE IX

The application for modification or amendment of the Articles of Incorporation or the By-Laws of the corporation shall be made only upon the affirmative vote of the majority of all members of the corporation present as set forth more particularly in the By-Laws of said corporation.
