The undersigned, acting hereby as Incorporator for the purpose of becoming a not-for-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, by and under the provisions of the status of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, liabilities, rights, privileges and immunities of a corporation not-for-profit, pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, and other applicable law, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is EARLY FLORIDA ARTS PRESERVATION FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE II

Duration

The term of existence of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The purpose of this corporation is to promote and support the preservation of early Florida art; to restore, purchase and maintain early Florida art for future generations; to receive public and private grants, donations from individuals, foundations and corporations; to derive income from the

operations of the Foundations; to have exhibits of early Florida art for the general public; and to engage in any lawful purpose or purposes not for pecuniary profit.
