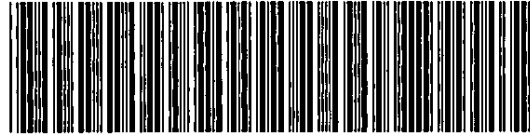

- A.
