ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

BANANA POINT HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

PALLARIAN SO PH IN 15

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a nonprofit corporation under the Florida Statutes, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation (hereinafter called the association) is BANANA POINT HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC., with its principal office address and mailing address at 1100 Main Street, Lady Lake, Florida, 92159.

ARTICLE II

The specific primary purposes for which the association is formed are to provide for the performance of duties delegated to the association pursuant to the Declaration of Restrictions of Banana Point Subdivision; and to promote the health, safety, and welfare of the residents within the above-described subdivision.

In furtherance of such purposes, the association shall have power to:

- (a) Perform all of the duties and obligations of the association set forth in the Declaration of Restrictions (the Declaration) applicable to the subdivision and to be recorded in the public records of Lake County, Florida;
- (b) Operate, maintain and manage the surface water or stormwater management system in a manner consistent with the St. Johns River Management District permit no. 42-069-0777N requirements and applicable District rules, and shall assist in the enforcement of the restrictions and covenants contained herein;
- (c) Affix, levy, and collect, and enforce payment by any lawful means of, an adequate assessment against members of the Association for the costs of maintenance and operation of the surface water or stormwater management system;
- (d) Use of the aforesaid assessment shall be for the maintenance and repair of the surface water or stormwater management systems, including but not limited to work within retention areas, drainage structures and drainage easements;
- (e) Affix, levy, and collect, and enforce payment by any lawful means of, all charges and assessments pursuant to the terms of the Declaration; and pay all expenses in connection therewith, and all office and other expenses incidental to the conduct of the business of the association, including all licenses, taxes, or governmental charges levied on or imposed against the property of the association;
- (f) Acquire (by gift, purchase, or otherwise), own, hold, and improve, build upon, operate, maintain, convey, sell, lease, transfer, dedicate to public use, or otherwise dispose of real and personal property in connection with the affairs of the association;

- (g) Borrow money and, subject to the consent by vote or written instrument of two-thirds of each class of members, mortgage, pledge, convey by deed of trust, or hypothecate any or all of its real or personal property as security for money borrowed or debts incurred;
- (h) Dedicate, sell, or transfer all or any part of any common areas to any municipality, public agency, authority, or utility for such purposes and subject to such conditions as may be agreed upon by the members. No such dedication or transfer shall be effective unless an instrument has been signed by two-thirds of each class of members, agreeing to such dedication, sale or transfer;
- (i) Participate in mergers and consolidations with other nonprofit corporations organized for the same purposes, or annex additional residential property or common areas, provided that any merger, consolidation, or annexation shall have the assent by vote or written instrument of two-thirds of each class of members;
- (j) Have and exercise any and all powers, rights and privileges that a nonprofit corporation organized under the Florida Statutes by law may now or horeafter have or exercise.

The association is organized and shall be operated exclusively for the purposes set forth above.

The activities of the association will be financed by assessments against members as provided in the

Declaration, and no part of any net carnings of the association will inure to the benefit of any member.

ARTICLE III

Every person or entity who is a record owner of a fee or undivided fee interest in any lot which is subject by covenants of record to assessment by the association, including contract sellers, but excluding persons or entities holding title merely as security for performance of an obligation, shall be a member of the association. Membership shall be appurtenant to and may not be separated from ownership of a lot which is subject to assessment by the association. Each lot shall have one vote.

ARTICLE IV

Existence of the Association shall commence with the filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Secretary of State, Tallahassee, Florida. The Association shall exist in perpetuity.

ARTICLE V

The affairs of the association shall be managed by a board of directors, and a president and secretary, who shall at all times be members of the board of directors. Such officers shall be elected at the first meeting of the board of directors following each annual meeting of members. The method by which directors are elected shall be as set forth in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE VII

The Bylaws of the association may be made, altered, or rescinded at any annual meeting of the association, or at any special meeting duly called for such purpose, on the affirmative vote of two-thirds of each class of members existing at the time of and present at such meeting, except that the initial Bylaws of the association shall be made and adopted by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VIII

Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation may be proposed by any member of the association.

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended at any annual meeting of the association, or at any special meeting duly called and held for such purpose, on the affirmative vote of a majority of members existing at the time of and present at such meeting.

ARTICLE IX

On dissolution, the assets of the association shall be distributed to an appropriate public agency to be used for purposes similar to those for which the association was created. In the event such distribution is refused acceptance, such assets shall be granted, conveyed and assigned to any nonprofit corporation, association, trust or other organization organized and operated for such similar purposes.

In the event of termination, dissolution or final liquidation of the Association, the responsibility for the operation and maintenance of the surface water or stormwater management system must be transferred to and accepted by an entity which would comply with Section 40C-2.027, <u>F.A.C.</u>, and be approved by the St. Johns River Water Management District prior to such termination, dissolution or liquidation.

ARTICLE X

The incorporator of the corporation shall be R. Dewey Burnsed, with his address at 1100 Main Street, Lady Lake, Florida 32159.

ARTICLE XI

The initial registered agent of the corporation shall be R. Dowey Burnsed, and the initial registered office of the corporation shall be 1100 Main Street, Lady Lake, Florida, 32159.
