Pursuant to the provisions of Florida Non-Profit Corporation Act, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Article of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation which: The corporation has no members. The following amendments to the Articles of Incorporation was adopted by the corporation board of directors on November 24, 1997, at 204 Essex Drive, Fort Pierce, Florida 34946. The Articles of Incorporation, are hereby amended so as to read as follows:

The purposes for which the Hadden Group Home, Inc., is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of section 50l(c)(3) OF The Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 50l(c)(3) of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 50l(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal, state, or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes.
