ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

EACH ONE TEACH ONE, INC.

The undersigned, acting as the incorporator of **EACH ONE TEACH ONE**, Inc.
Under Chapter 617, Florida Statues, submits the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE ONE: NAME

The name of the corporation is:

ARTICLE TWO: DURATION AND COMMENCEMENT

The Corporation will exist perpetually, commencing with the filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Florida Department of State.

ARTICLE THREE: PURPOSE

The Corporation is organized exclusively for such charitable, educational, literary, or scientific purposes, as will qualify it for exemption from federal income tax as an organization described by Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future United States Internal Revenue Law. Within the scope of the forgoing, the Corporation is specifically organized and empowered:

i) To write, develop, teach, produce and distribute materials including but not limited to video, audio and written materials to promote discipleship and the ability to learn to live a God-focused, God-centered and Christian life.

- ii) To offer and provide, within stated guidelines, as set-in the by-laws of the corporation, financial or other service assistance to new and recommitted believers in order to meet their physical needs as may be necessary to promote their physical, mental, emotional and spiritual health and growth.
- iii) To accept, hold, administer, invest and disburse for such purposes or for other scientific, educational, literary, charitable or religious purposes, such funds as may from time to time be given to it by any person, persons or corporations; and receive gifts and make financial and other types of contributions and assistance to scientific, educational, literary, charitable and to engage in such other activities as are necessary, appropriate, or convenient to the furtherance of the foregoing stated purposes and permitted under the laws of Florida and of the United States.

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, unless such member director, officer or other private person is itself an organization qualifying for exemption from federal income tax as an organization described by Section 501 (c)(3) a of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding section of any future United States Internal Revenue Law and except as reasonable compensation for services rendered or to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this Article Three. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except to the extent permitted pursuant to an election made under Section 501 (h) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986), and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in

(including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

ARTICLE FOUR: MEMBERS

The qualifications for members of the Corporation and the manner of their admission shall be as regulated by the bylaws.

ARTICLE FIVE: INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

ARTICLE SIX: ADDRESS
