ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CABALLERO HAULING, INC.



ARTICLE I--NAME and PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The name of this corporation is CABALLERO HAULING, INC., and its principal place of business is 908 Lemonwood Avenue West, Bradenton, Florida, 34207.
