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**Dear Sirs:**

**We are enclosing herewith a completed application for reinstatement for The Tomato Patch, Inc. for failure to file this form for the 1998 and 1999 years.**

**We would like to make you aware of the following:**

**The Tomato Patch, Inc. is owned and operated by a resident alien who came to our country several years ago with the hope of creating a profitable business and ultimately becoming a United States citizen. Mr. Zaidman, the owner, knew nothing of federal or Floridan law and relied upon a Florida attorney and accountant to prepare whatever forms where necessary for his business to be effectuated. It would take a considerable amount of time to explain how the original tax returns filed by the Florida accountant were erroneous and how their filing cost Mr. Zaidman several thousands of dollars. However, because he was concentrating on the growth of his business, Mr. Zaidman continued to rely on those professionals he hired.**

**At the beginning of 1998, Mr. Zaidman sold the food/catering portion of his business to another person and with the proceeds from the sale as well as additional monies invested by himself, purchased the Venice Beach Apartments. Because of immigration rules, Mr. Zaidman had to maintain the original corporate name of The Tomato Patch, Inc. and contacted the Internal Revenue Service and Florida sales tax bureau to report the address change. Mr. Zaidman decided to change accounting firms because he began to see that his bookkeeping/accounting work was not being prepared on a timely basis. At about the same time, I began coming to Florida to work on a Pennsylvania client who had relocated to Venice. At this point, I was introduced to Mr. Zaidman and we began making arrangements for me to do his accounting work. Because there was so much confusion regarding the retrieval of certain records from his former accountant, I put the corporation on an extension for their federal return. Sales tax returns were timely filed as were payroll returns. However, it appears that the Florida corporate returns were being mailed to The Tomato Patch, Inc.'s former address of 125 W. Venice Avenue instead of to the new address of 501 W. Venice Avenue. None of these returns were forwarded to Mr. Zaidman and he was unaware that they had not been filed.**

**Several weeks ago it came to my attention that these forms need to be filled out each year. Mr. Zaidman's wife contacted your agency and was assured that the address change was complete. Your office forwarded the enclosed application which I have filled out.**


**We are enclosing a check in the amount of \$ 300 for both unfiled years and respectfully request that your office reinstate this corporation. The Zaidmans are hard-working, dedicated people who want nothing more than to become American citizens and succeed in their business. Had they known about the requirement to file this return, I can assure you that it would have been done. If the person who received the returns at their old address had forwarded the returns to them, Mr. Zaidman would have sent them to me to prepare and once again, I assure you that they would have timely been sent.**

Please take into consideration the above circumstances when filing this return. To have to pay so much more money for non-filing based on the above would be so unfair. We hope that you will be understanding and reinstate this corporation for the normal filing fee.

All future returns will be timely filed.
