
Thank you for taking my telephone call today regarding my attempted filing of Articles of Incorporation for A-1, Inc., and the possible name conflict which this corporation might have with the trademark "AI-," Document Number T93000000902, which trademark is owned by Aurora International Inc..

After you expressed concern that the "I" in "AI-" might refer to the Roman numeral one which would result in a conflict with "A-1, Inc.," I called Aurora International, Inc. at (954) 425-0661 and spoke to a Dr. Steve Twining, who indicated that he was Vice President for Operations of Aurora International, Inc. He verified to me that the "I" in "AI-" indeed was the letter "I" because they intended for their trademark to have the initials of their company in it. This also corresponds with your office's alphabetizing and indexing of AI- in the "AI's" rather than the "AI's" when your office accepted the filing of the trademark.

Given this new information, I respectfully request that you allow CSC Networks to file the Articles of Incorporation of A-1, Inc., on behalf of my clients as soon as possible.

The undersigned Incorporator subscribing to these Articles of Incorporation, being competent to contract, hereby forms a Corporation under the Laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

The name of this Corporation shall be: A-1, INC., and its initial mailing address shall be: 1104 81st Street South, St. Petersburg, Florida 33707. The initial address of the Corporation's principal office shall be: 1104 81st Street South, St. Petersburg, Florida 33707.

ARTICLE II


