ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF P. M. ECKMAN ADVERTISING, INC.

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation is P. M. ECKMAN ADVERTISING, INC.

ARTICLE II

The period of duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The purpose for which the Corporation is organized is to include any and all legal activities permitted under the Laws of the State of Florida and the United States.

The Corporation, subject to any specific written limitations or restrictions imposed by the Law or by these Articles of Incorporation, shall have and exercise the following powers:

- (a) To have and exercise all the powers specified by law:

The enumeration of specific powers shall not be construed as limiting or restricting in any manner either the meaning of general terms used in any of these clauses, or the scope of the general powers of the Corporation created by them, nor shall the expression of one thing in any of these clauses be deemed to exclude another not expressed, although it be of like nature.
