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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, a natural person competent to contract, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, Chapter 607, <u>Fla. Stat.</u> (1995), as amended, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation.

Article 1 Name

The name of this corporation is:

H20 Art, Inc.

Article 2 Duration

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual, commencing on the date these Articles are filed in the office of the Secretary of State of Florida.

Article 3
Purpose

The purpose of this corporation is to engage in any activities or business permitted under the laws of the United States and Florida.

Article 4 Capital Stock

The corporation is authorized to issue 1,000 shares of common stock with each share having a par value of \$.001. All shareholders shall have preemptive rights in future stock sales by the corporation.
