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FINAL JUDGMENT OF DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

THIS CAUSE came on before the Court for final hearing on June 5, 2002, upon the Petition for Dissolution of Marriage filed by the Petitioner/Wife. The Wife and her attorney were present. The Husband had notice of the final hearing. After reviewing the Court file, the evidence presented and otherwise being fully advised of the circumstances, it is hereby

ORDER AND ADJUDGED as follows:

- 1. The Petitioner has been a resident of the State of Florida for more than six (6) months prior to the filing of the Petition for Dissolution of Marriage.
- 2. The marriage of the Petitioner/Wife, BETTY CHRISTINE HALE, and the Respondent/Husband, TODD STEPHEN HALE, shall be and is hereby dissolved because it is irretrievably broken.

8. Hale Contracting, Inc. The Husband owns 40% of the stock of Hale Contracting, Inc. (200 shares). Both parties have worked for Hale Contracting and the Wife is still employed by Hale Contracting, Inc. Due to marital efforts, the assets and/or stock of Hale Contracting has increased in value substantially during the marriage. The Husband's stock in Hale Contracting is a marital asset and subject to equitable distribution. The Husband has committed dissipation of marital assets as a result of his drug use. He has paid for drugs during the marriage from the parties' joint checking account as well as from marital funds, thus depriving the Wife of marital assets.

Whereas Hale Contracting, Inc. is a Florida Corporation and this Court has jurisdiction over the stock of Hale Contracting, Inc., of which there are 500 shares total with a par value of \$1.00 each when issued, and the Husband, TODD STEPHEN HALE, owns 200 shares. Ownership of _ ____ of the Husband's, TODD STEPHEN HALE, stock in Hale Contracting, Inc. is hereby transferred to the Wife, BETTY CHRISTINE HALE. Hale Contracting, Inc. and/or its agent is ordered to immediately comply with the terms of this paragraph and transfer or issue ownership of this stock to the Wife by whatever action is necessary.

The Court retains jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter to enter 9. any subsequent orders relating to child support and/or parental responsibility.
